Membership Categories

Full Membership \$185.00 (Discount for early payment by 29th November \$160)

A full member is entitled to a non-transferable Members badge and guest badge. One annual member's car parking pass which provides parking in the Members car park.

Optional purchase: one second guest badge \$43. Full voting privileges.

Full Membership Pensioner \$130.00 (Discount for early payment by 29th November \$113.50)

Members who are now Pensioners or the holder of a Health Benefit or Veteran Affairs card must notify the office and produce their Concession Card to receive the discount.

Optional purchase: one second guest badge \$43. Full voting privileges.

Membership For Life \$1850.00

Pay a once off fee to become a Member for Life. Includes a non-transferable Member for Life badge and guest badge. One annual members car parking pass which provides parking in the Members car park. *Optional purchase*: one second guest badge \$43. Full voting privileges.

Senior Membership \$102.50 (Discount for early payment by 29th November \$90)

For Members who have retained their Membership for a continuous period of not less than 25 consecutive years. Members who are eligible for Senior membership will be notified by the Club *Optional purchase*: one second guest badge \$43. Full voting privileges.

Honorary Membership

At the discretion of the Board. Honorary members are not required to pay a membership fee. Honorary Members do not have voting privileges.

General Information

Paying your membership subscription:

All TTC Members are sent a subscription Invoice in July each year. Payment can be made via the website www.tasmanianturfclub.com - in person - or over the phone via a credit card.

New Members

Any proposed new Members must complete the Members Application form or via the website www.tasmanianturfclub.com Any new member joining after the Launceston Cup Carnival will receive membership for the remaining year and the following year.

Change of Address

Should your address or any personal contact details change, including phone, email and address you are required to advise the Club at your earliest convenience or update your members account via the website www.tasmanianturfclub.com. As the Club is mindful of the environment and the cost of postage, we often utilise email as our preferred communication to update members. If you are not receiving emails from us please call to advise your email address or update via the website www.tasmanianturfclub.com

Members Lounge

This area is for the exclusive use of Tasmanian Turf Club, Tasmanian Racing Club and Devonport Racing Club Members at all meetings. Any Member of a mainland Club which the Tasmanian Turf Club observes reciprocity can obtain on production of their Members Badge a special ticket to gain admittance to this area.

Other Useful Information

Misuse of Membership Badges

Are strictly non-transferable under any circumstances and any Member found not adhering to this will automatically forfeit his or her Membership of the Club.

Voting Privileges

The attention of Article 15 of the Club's Rules and Regulations which provides that no Member shall be competent to vote on any occasion whatsoever or exercise any of the rights or privileges of a Member unless he/she has paid his/her subscription for the current year. Honorary members are ineligible to vote.

Reciprocal Privileges within Tasmania

By arrangement with the Tasmanian Racing Club and the Devonport Racing Club, Members and holders of Guest Badges of this Club are admitted free entry and entry to the Members Reserve for all meetings conducted by the Tasmanian Racing Club and the Devonport Racing Club.

Reciprocal Privileges Outside of Tasmania

This Club has reciprocal privileges with various Interstate Racing Clubs. With the exception of major race days members are required to show their TTC badge and will be given complimentary members passes. The limit varies at each Club and we suggest you contact the relevant Club to establish prices and procedures for gaining access prior to attending the meeting.

Members Car Park

Passes for the Members Car Park and presentation of members badge can be used to enter this area. Guest badges do not allow entry to this area. Obtaining a car park in the Members car park is not guaranteed and is subject to availability. It is recommended that you arrive early on feature racedays.

Reserved Dining Facilities

Members dining facilities are available on all race days/nights and bookings are strictly required. The Club mainly serve a two course buffet at most race meetings however this may change from time to time for special or themed meetings. Members are encouraged to book on-line through our website www.tasmanianturfclub.com There are special arrangements for reserved dining facilities on Ladbrokes Launceston Cup day, please phone the Club for any enquires.

Members Snack Bar

For those members who are not dining but would like to sit and view races, have a snack and a drink in the members, the members snack bar situated at the end of the Members Lounge is open each raceday/night including Ladbrokes Launceston Cup day.

Member's Lounge Dress Regulations

The Clubs dress standards will be enforced throughout the racing season. To avoid any inconvenience please ensure that your attire and that of your guests is appropriate for the Members Lounge. The Board reserve the right to refuse entry to any person considered inappropriately attired.

Gentlemen: entering the Members Reserve must wear a shirt with collar attached with tailored trousers or chinos. Dress shoes or leather boat shoes must be worn. A Jacket and tie is only required on Launceston Cup day. Not permitted - any variation of runner including joggers, thongs, jodhpurs, denim, shorts, shirts without a collar, parkas, windbreakers, tracksuits, peaked caps, beanies, sporting guernseys, torn or ripped clothing.

Ladies: Racewear, expected to maintain a suitable standard in keeping with the dignity of the Members Enclosure. As per not permitted above including denim and any clothing revealing excessive bare midriff.

Members Guests: Members are reminded of their responsibility for ensuring the attire of guests introduced into the Members Lounge conforms to the required standard.

Children

Children under 16 accompanied by an adult receive free entry to the course and Members area. Children entering the Members area must be supervised at all times.

Owners Entry

Owners listed in the race book who have a horse running at any meeting may collect two Owners Passes at the main gate. Syndicates are requested to contact the office to arrange passes.

Members Entry

Entry for Members and holders of guest passes is granted by scanning your current, renewed TTC Membership badge or guest badge through the turnstiles. Please note if you have not paid your membership by the required date your membership & guest badge/s will become inactive and you will not be able to gain entry to the course.

Lost Members & Guest Badges

The loss or theft of Membership badges must be reported to the Club as soon as possible so that unauthorised use can be prevented. A replacement badge will be issued upon receipt of a written submission explaining the circumstances of the loss. A small fee of \$20 is payable for the replacement of Members badges and guest badges.

Forgotten Members Badges on Racedays/Nights

Should you forget your Membership badge on a raceday/night your will be required to pay the racecourse general admission fee and present yourself at the Office where on presentation of appropriate identification, a temporary badge will be issued for the day.

Raceday/Night Contact

If you wish to provide feedback or speak directly with a TTC representative please present yourself at the raceday/night Office or phone 03 63 261070. Feedback can also be left in our suggestion box located in the Members lounge.

Liquor Licence

Members and their guests must observe the Liquor Licencing Regulations in place at the racecourse. The TTC and its caterers follow guidelines for Responsible Service of Alcohol. By law staff members must not serve any alcoholic beverages to guests under the age of 18 or to guests deemed to be in a state of intoxication.

Discrimination

The TTC is committed to ensuring that the racecourse is a welcoming and inclusive place for all. The TTC expects that every person who visits or works at the course will act with respect and decency towards one another at all times, in an environment free from discrimination and vilification.

Is there an ATM on course?

Yes there is an ATM located on level 1 and cash out is also available from the office.

What type of food can be purchased on course?

Takeaway & fast food options are available from the punters bar located near the entrance to the grandstand.

Counter meals are available from the ground floor Ladbrokes Punters Lounge
